and exterior spaces.” A contemporary home that exhibits livability rather than a cooled inner landscape, warm wood features abound, blending beautifully with light flows. “This is a home for a young family, not a gallery,” affirms Hindle.

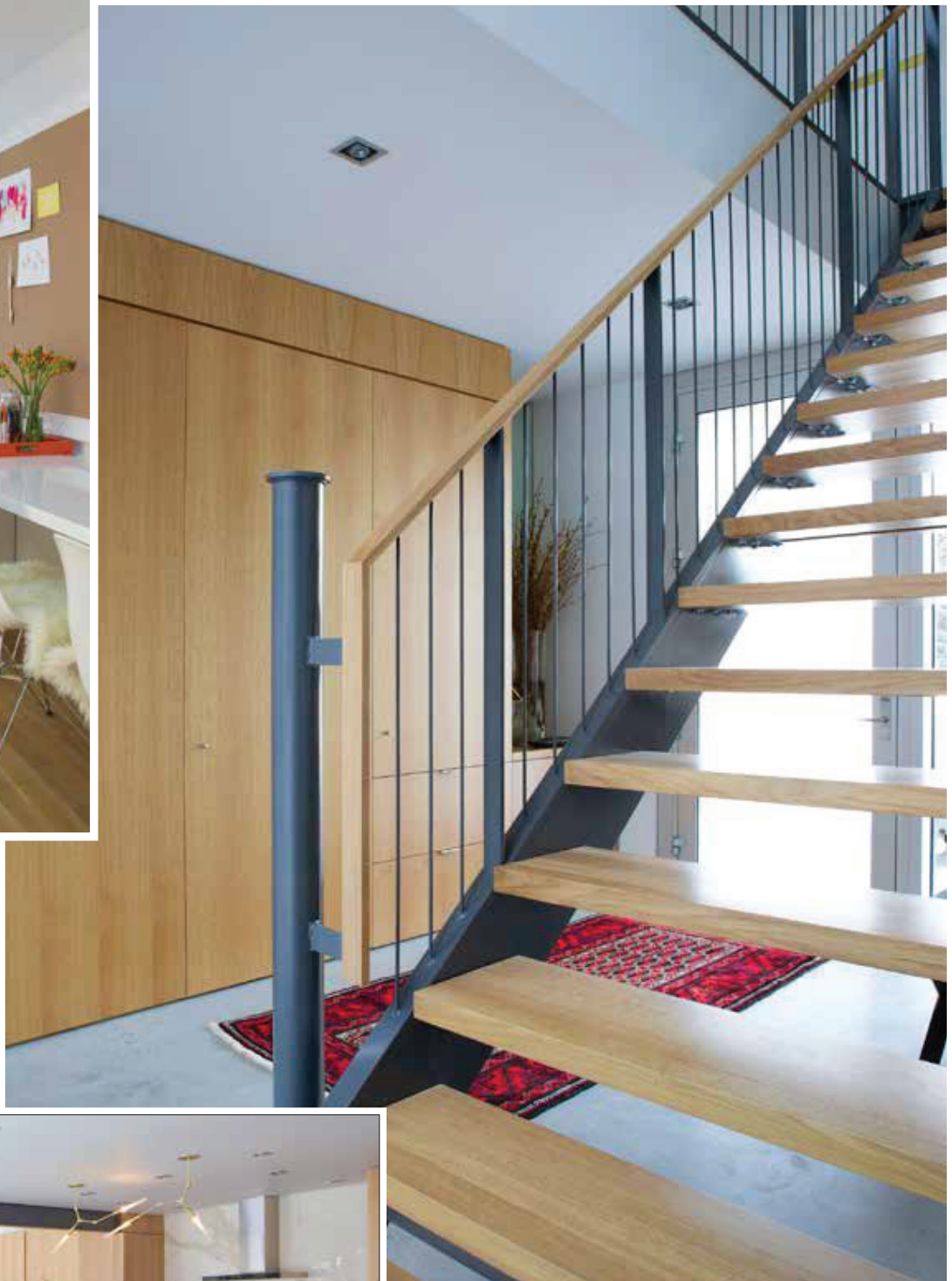
Presenting a level of execution that is phenomenal, each team member collaborated to understand the intent of the design and how it translated into subtleties and details. Representing a keen interpretation of single and two-story living, the home delivers the privacy one would desire with maximized flows and function.

“The family wanted a simple arrangement of spaces that was interconnected from floor to floor, which was achieved through a thoughtful, open floor plan where natural light penetrates deep into the house,” explains Hindle. The volumes of the home and its connections carry through to the main floor staircase and bridge, allowing daylight to flow into the basement.

Awash with light from morning to night, north-facing clerestory windows offer additional ambient light, providing significant

A collaborative combination of post and beam and staircase features in site-finished steel offsets the concrete floors in the kitchen and great room with modern charm. American white oak millwork provides a smooth contrast in a flat-panel design with aluminum hardware. Quartz countertops and a back-splash of Calcutta marble offer an elegant balance of surfaces.

Structural steel stringers, spindles, and newel posts blend with American white oak, open-riser treads, enhancing views at entry to the rear of the home and its backyard. Continuous millwork sets the stage for well-crafted style.



The open master bedroom and ensuite provides an arresting flow of function and finishes. Connected through millwork design, the very creative wall unit acts as a divider, doubling as the headboard in the bedroom. White, lacquered cabinetry hosts marble surfaces amidst large format, porcelain floor tile. Back-painted glass tile adorns the curbless shower. The standalone both features floor-mounted faucets.



energy-savings. Radiant in-floor heat in the basement and main level is further supplemented by the sun's warmth on these concrete surfaces. Passive cooling is achieved by the home's narrow width and abundance of operational windows.

Showcasing a delightful combination of structural steel posts and beams in the interior, the exterior is favourably balanced with aluminum fascia and panels that align window features. Stonewater further built the cohesive cabinetry and millwork in American white oak on site.

Unique in its approach, the home achieves harmony within the community while contributing something original. "From the beginning Stonewater, the architect, and the homeowners shared a considered approach as to how one could create a contemporary home within a traditional neighborhood through scale and massing that was compatible with the existing context," shares Kevin Graham.

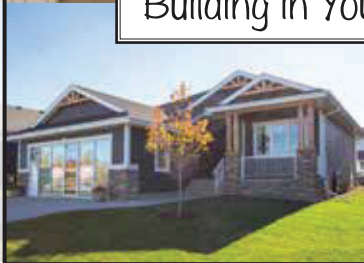
